

Writing Process Reflection

In this reflective essay, you will reconsider how you write by engaging with important texts from the writing process and cognitivist movements. Citing at least two of the academic articles we have read, put your writing experiences in conversation with their scholarship. The overall questions for you to explore are: *How do your writing experiences fit into — or not fit into — the models that Sommers, Perl, Rose, and/or Williams offer? What new insights into your own writing have these articles helped you make?*

Requirements:

- 2-3 pages
- Double spaced
- Cite *at least two* different articles
- Include —and analyze! — direct quotations from your secondary sources
- Use MLA citation style: in-text parentheticals and a works cited list at the end
